Learning objective: To use capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences correctly.

Read the story about Max the monkey below. He has forgotten to add his capital letters and full stops! Add a capital letter to the start of each sentence and a full stop at the end.

max runs a fruit store he sells yellow bananas for two pounds each a big monkey comes to the store he buys three bananas max is very happy

1. How many sentences can you find in the story? Write the number below. (1 mark)

2. Rewrite the first sentence correctly, making sure you include a capital letter and a full stop. (2 marks)

3. Why does Max need a capital letter at the start of his name? (2 marks)

4. Look at the sentence about the big monkey. Add the missing full stop in the right place. (1 mark)

5. If a banana costs £2, how much would two bananas cost? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey standing in his fruit store with a basket of bananas.



Extension challenge: Write one new sentence about what else Max might sell in his store. Remember to start with a capital letter and end with a full stop!
