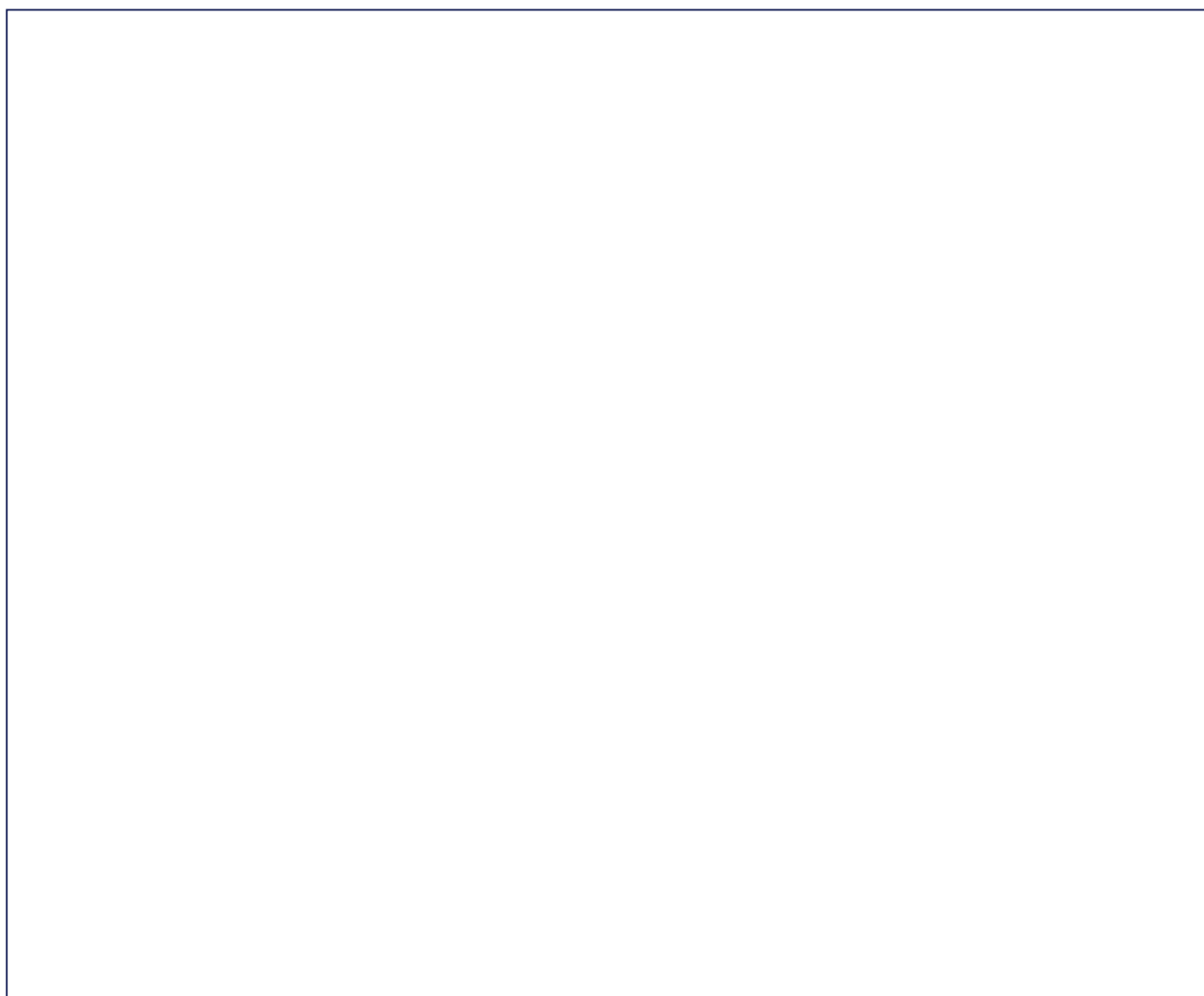


Pip the Bookworm's Cosy Reading Nook

Learning objective: To develop comprehension skills by visualising a narrative scene and labelling key objects.

Look at the list of words below. Read them carefully, then draw Pip the caterpillar in a special place where he likes to read. Make sure to include the items from the word bank in your picture!

Draw: Draw a bright, colorful scene featuring Pip the caterpillar. Use a friendly, storybook illustration style. Pip should be wearing a little pair of glasses. Include a big green leaf for him to sit on, a soft cushion, and an open book. Add the sun in the corner of the sky and a tall tree in the background. Use crayons or pencils to add lots of texture to the grass and leaves.



Label words: Pip · book · cushion · leaf · tree · sun

Steps:

1. Who is the main character in our story?
2. Where did Pip decide to sit to read his book?
3. What does Pip use to make his reading spot feel soft?
4. If Pip bought a new book for £2, and he has a £5 note, how much change would he get?
5. Draw a line to show where you would place the 'sun' in your picture.
