

Max's Magnificent Math Story

Learning objective: To use capital letters, full stops, and conjunctions to write a simple story.

Help Max the monkey write a story about his day at the market. Remember to use a capital letter at the start of every sentence and a full stop at the end. Use the word bank to join your ideas together.

Max the monkey skipped to the market to buy some fruit for his friends.

Word bank: and · but · so · because · then · next · after that

1. What did Max decide to buy first? Start your sentence with: First, Max found... (2 marks)

2. How much did the fruit cost? Use the word 'and' to write about two items. Start your sentence with: The apples cost £2 and... (2 marks)

3. Who did Max meet at the market? Start your sentence with: Max saw his friend who was... (2 marks)

4. How did Max feel at the end of the day? Start your sentence with: Max felt happy because... (2 marks)

5. Can you write one final sentence about what Max did when he got home? Start your sentence with: When he got home, he... (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you add an adjective to describe the fruit? For example, instead of 'apple', try 'shiny, red apple'.
