

Pip's Super Spelling Adventure!

Stretch the sounds, catch the letters, and watch your words come to life!

- A sound is a tiny part of a word that we hear with our ears.
- We use our alphabet letters to write down the sounds we hear.
- To spell a word, say it slowly and stretch the sounds out like a piece of elastic.
- Look for the tricky letters that join together to make one sound.
- Blending is when we put all our sounds back together to read the whole word.
- Practising a little bit every day helps your brain remember the patterns.

Did you know? Did you know? Pip the caterpillar has a special collection of words! When he finds a new word, he breaks it into tiny sound-pieces to help him remember how to spell it. This is called segmenting!
