

Pip's Word Collection Journal

Learning objective: To practice segmenting and blending sounds to spell simple CVC words and common exception words.

Help Pip the caterpillar build his word collection! Look at the pictures or think of your favorite things. Write the words in the boxes by listening for the sounds you can hear. Practice writing the letters carefully and check if your word matches the sound.

Word bank: cat · dog · sun · hat · pen · bus · the · and

1. My First Word: Choose a word for an object you can see in the room. Write it here by sounding it out. (2 marks)

2. My Second Word: Think of an animal. Can you spell its name? Try to write one sound for each letter. (2 marks)

3. My Third Word: Think of something you like to eat. Write the letters you hear in the word. (2 marks)

4. My Color Word: Pick a color you like. Can you spell it for Pip? (2 marks)

5. My Sentence: Use one of your words from above to write a little sentence, like 'The cat is big'. (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Choose your favorite word from your collection and draw a picture to go with it at the bottom of the page. Can you show a grown-up how you used your robot arms to sound out the letters?
