Learning objective: To identify and use ambitious vocabulary to enhance descriptive writing.

Choose words that are powerful, unusual, or paint a vivid picture in the reader's mind. Fill in the sections below to build your own vocabulary collection.

1. The New Discovery: Write down a new word you have found while reading today. What type of word is it (noun, verb, or adjective)? (2 marks)

2. Definition Station: Explain what the word means in your own words. You might want to use a dictionary to help you. (3 marks)

3. Synonym Search: Can you think of two other words that mean almost the same thing? List them here. (2 marks)

4. Context Clues: Write a sentence of your own using this new word. Make sure your sentence helps the reader understand what the word means. (3 marks)

5. Visualise It: Describe how this word makes you feel or what it makes you think of. Does it sound soft, sharp, fast, or slow? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Choose two of your collected words and write a short, four-line poem where they are both used to describe a scene in nature.
