

Pip's Word Collector Journal

Learning objective: To develop vocabulary by identifying and using descriptive adjectives and nouns to describe objects and experiences.

Help Pip the bookworm caterpillar find new words! Look around your classroom or garden, pick an interesting object, and fill in the boxes below to build your own word collection. Use the word bank to help you describe what you find.

Word bank: shiny · bumpy · gigantic · tiny · bright · soft · smooth · colorful · loud · quiet

1. My Word Choice: Write down the name of the object you have chosen to describe.

2. What does it look like? Use a word from the bank to describe the appearance.

3. What does it feel like? Think about the texture (e.g., is it soft or bumpy?).

4. The Action Word: What does this object do? (e.g., 'The ball rolls', 'The bird sings').

5. My Sentence: Write a full sentence using your new words to tell Pip about your object.

Extension challenge: Can you find a partner and tell them your new words? See if you can find a synonym (a word that means the same thing) for your favorite word.
