Learning objective: To develop reading comprehension skills by retrieving information, making inferences, and expressing personal opinions about a text.

Read the story carefully and answer the questions below. Remember to use full sentences for your answers.

Pip the caterpillar was wearing a tiny paper crown, and Zara the zebra had painted colorful stripes on her sweater to look like her favorite storybook hero.
