

Rosa's French Body Parts Poster

Join Rosa the Parrot and build your French vocabulary, one body part at a time!

- **La tête** is the French word for your head. Remember that 'la' tells us it is a feminine noun.
- **Le nez** is your nose. You can remember this because it sounds very similar to the English word!
- **Les yeux** are your eyes. Even though it is a plural word, it is easy to spot in a sentence.
- **Les mains** are your hands. Use these to wave 'bonjour' to your friends.
- **Les pieds** are your feet. These help you walk or run during your daily adventures.

Did you know? Did you know? In French, nouns have a 'gender'. Words like 'tête' and 'bouche' are feminine, so we use 'la'. Words like 'nez' are masculine, so we use 'le'. When talking about more than one, like your eyes or ears, we use 'les'!
