

La Mode avec Rosa le Perroquet

Enfile ton style ! (Put on your style!) Discover the colorful world of French fashion with Rosa.

- To say 'I am wearing' in French, we use the phrase 'Je porte'.
- Masculine items of clothing usually start with 'un', such as 'un pantalon'.
- Feminine items of clothing usually start with 'une', such as 'une robe'.
- Plural items, like shoes, use 'des', for example, 'des chaussures'.
- Remember: Adjectives of color go after the noun, for example: 'un pull rouge' (a red sweater).

Did you know? Did you know? In France, the word 'mode' means fashion. Just like in the UK, French fashion trends change with the seasons. When it is 'hiver' (winter), people wear a warm 'manteau', but when it is 'été' (summer), they prefer a light 't-shirt'!
