

French Assessment: Les Jours de la Semaine

Learning objective: To recall, identify, and use the days of the week in French, understanding their sequence and spelling.

Read each question carefully. Rosa the parrot has provided a word bank to help you. Write your answers clearly in French where requested.

Rosa the parrot is busy planning her weekly schedule for language lessons. She starts her week on Monday and finishes her final lesson on Sunday.

Word bank: lundi · mardi · mercredi · jeudi · vendredi · samedi · dimanche · Aujourd'hui · Demain

1. Write the French days of the week in the correct order, starting with Monday (lundi). (7 marks)

2. Translate the following into French: 'Today is Tuesday'. (2 marks)

3. If today is mercredi (Wednesday), what day is it tomorrow (demain)? Write your answer in French. (2 marks)

4. Rosa says: 'J'aime le samedi et le dimanche.' Explain in English what Rosa likes and why these days are often special for children. (4 marks)

5. Fill in the blanks: 'Après le lundi, c'est le _____. Après le vendredi, c'est le _____.' (5 marks)

6. Extended Writing: Write five sentences in French about your week. For example, mention what day you have a favorite lesson or what you do on a specific day. (5 marks)

Draw: Draw a calendar for the week and label each day in French. Add a small picture next to each day to show one activity you do (e.g., a book for reading on Monday).
