

Rosa's Wonderful Week: Les Jours de la Semaine

Join Rosa the parrot on a linguistic adventure and learn to name your week in French!

- The week begins with 'lundi', which represents the Moon (la Lune).
- Mid-week is 'mercredi', which is named after the planet Mercury.
- The school week ends on 'vendredi', named after Venus.
- The weekend begins with 'samedi' and finishes with 'dimanche'.
- To ask what day it is, you say: 'Quel jour sommes-nous ?'

Did you know? Did you know? In French, the days of the week are not written with a capital letter unless they start a sentence! They are named after planets and Roman gods, similar to how English days are named after Norse gods and celestial bodies.
