

Rosa's Tasty French Feast

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for common foods, expressing likes and dislikes using 'J'aime' and 'Je n'aime pas'.

Read the passage below about Rosa the parrot's picnic. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions. Remember to use 'J'aime' (I like) and 'Je n'aime pas' (I do not like) in your responses.

Bonjour! I am Rosa. Today, I am hosting a picnic in the forest. I have brought a delicious spread for my friends. I love to eat le fromage and le pain. However, even though I am a parrot, I really do not enjoy les légumes! My friend Leo the lion loves to eat le poisson, but he finds la pomme a bit crunchy. For dessert, we all agree that la glace is the best treat of all.

Word bank: la pomme (apple) · le fromage (cheese) · le pain (bread) · la glace (ice cream) · les légumes (vegetables) · le poisson (fish) · J'aime (I like) · Je n'aime pas (I do not like)

1. Using the passage, write one sentence in French about what Rosa likes to eat and one sentence about what she does not like. (2 marks)

2. Explain why Leo might prefer to eat le poisson rather than la pomme. Use evidence from the text. (2 marks)

3. If you were at the picnic, which item from the word bank would you choose to eat? Write your answer in French: 'J'aime...' followed by the food item. (1 mark)

4. Compare and contrast the food preferences of Rosa and Leo. What is the one thing they both agree on? (3 marks)

Draw: Draw a plate of food for Rosa's picnic. Label at least three items on your plate using the correct French nouns from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Justify your answer: If Rosa were to invite a new friend who is a vegetarian, which items from the picnic would be suitable for them? Explain why you would exclude certain items and what you might add to the menu to make it more inclusive.
