

Rosa's Radiant Greetings Challenge

Learning objective: To correctly identify and use formal and informal French greetings and phrases to suit different social situations.

Rosa the parrot is helping her friends at the park. Read the social situation described in each question. Choose the most appropriate French greeting or phrase from the word bank to complete the dialogue. Write your answer in the space provided.

Word bank: Bonjour · Salut · Enchanté · Au revoir · Ça va ? · Comment allez-vous ? · À bientôt

1. 1. Max the monkey meets his teacher for the first time. He wants to be polite and formal. What should he say? (2 marks)

2. 2. Pip the caterpillar sees his best friend, Kit, in the morning. He wants to say a friendly 'Hello'. What should he say? (2 marks)

3. 3. Nova the owl is feeling curious and wants to ask her friend how they are doing today. What phrase should she use? (2 marks)

4. 4. Ellie the elephant is leaving the library and says goodbye to the librarian. What is a polite way for her to say goodbye? (2 marks)

5. 5. Zara the zebra meets a new friend at an art gallery. After being introduced, she says 'Nice to meet you'. What is the French phrase for this? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a speech bubble coming from Rosa the parrot. Inside the bubble, draw a scene where two of our BookFlik friends are meeting each other. Label the characters with their chosen French greeting.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are meeting a new pen pal from France. Write a short introduction using at least three of the greetings from our word bank, adding your name and one hobby you enjoy.
