

Rosa's French Greetings Garden

Learning objective: To learn and use common French greetings and polite phrases in a creative context.

Help Rosa the parrot design her French Garden! Use the vocabulary in the word bank to label your drawing and show who is saying what.

Draw: Draw a colorful, sunny garden scene. Include Rosa the parrot sitting on a tree branch. Add at least two other garden characters (like a bee or a squirrel) greeting each other. Use speech bubbles for your French phrases. The art style should be bright, friendly, and clear, with plenty of room to write your French labels next to the characters.



Label words: Bonjour · Salut · Au revoir · Ça va ? · Bien, merci · Enchanté

Steps:

1. Draw Rosa the parrot perched on a branch. Write 'Bonjour' in a speech bubble coming from her beak.
2. Draw a friend meeting Rosa for the first time. Label the friend saying 'Enchanté'.
3. Draw a sunset in the background. Write 'Au revoir' near the sun to show it is time to say goodbye.
4. Rosa asks 'Ça va ?'. Write a response in French that means 'I am well, thank you'.
5. Why do we use different greetings depending on the time of day or who we are talking to? Explain your thoughts.
