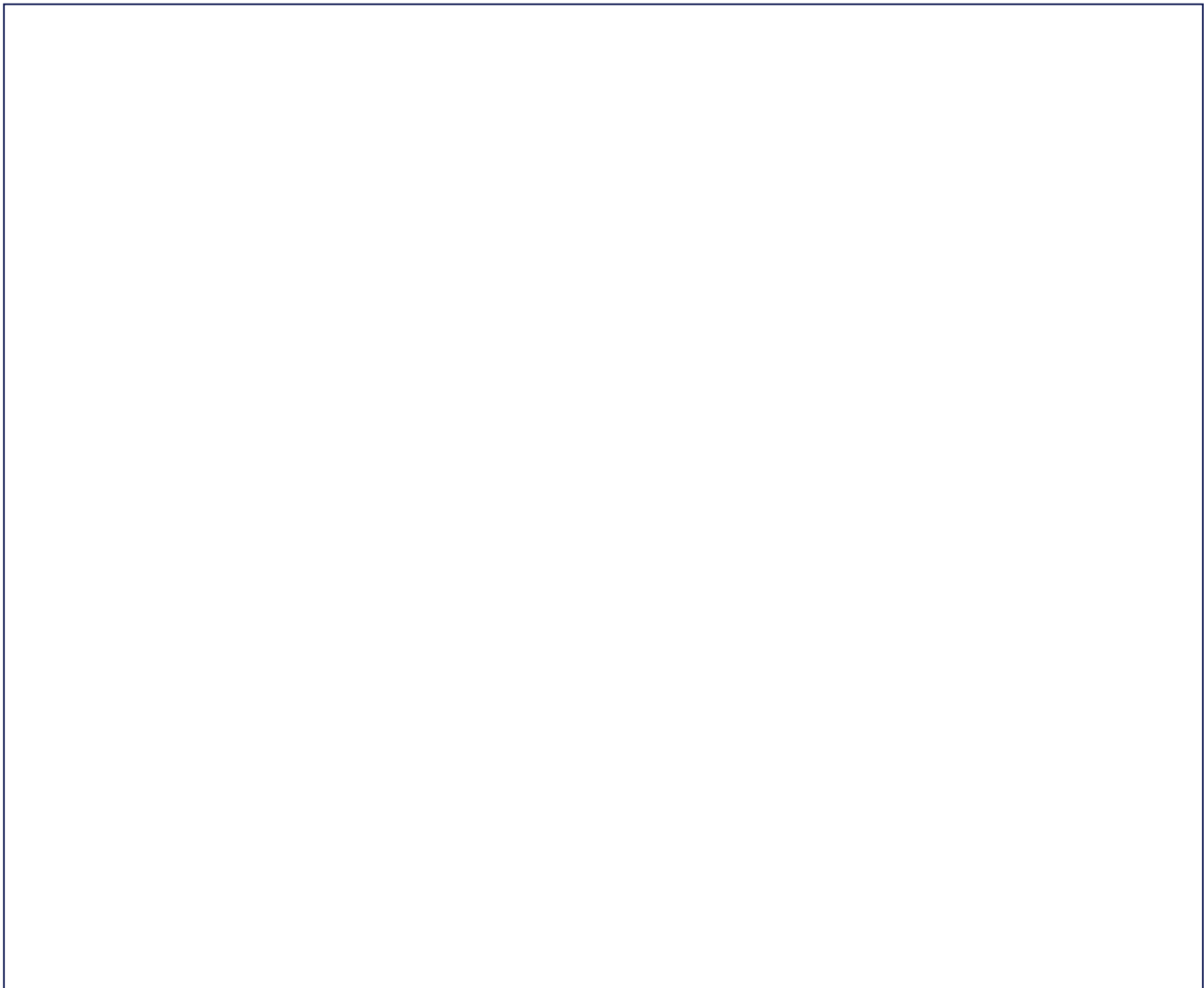


Rosa's Hobby Gallery: Mes Loisirs

Learning objective: To identify and describe hobbies using French vocabulary and apply them to a creative visual context.

Follow the drawing prompt below to create your own 'Loisirs' (hobbies) gallery. Use the labels from the word bank to annotate your artwork in French. Be as creative as possible!

Draw: Create a split-screen illustration showing four different hobbies. In each section, draw yourself or a generic character engaged in the activity. Use a vibrant, colorful style. Include specific details like a football in the grass for 'Je joue au football' or a paintbrush and canvas for 'J'aime dessiner'. Ensure there is enough white space around the drawings to neatly write the French labels provided in the word bank.



Label words: Je joue au football · J'aime lire · Je joue de la guitare · Je fais de la natation · J'aime dessiner · Je fais du vélo

Steps:

1. Identify one hobby from your drawing that involves physical exercise. Write the French phrase and explain why it is important for a healthy lifestyle.
2. Compare and contrast two of your hobbies. Which one requires more concentration? Justify your answer.
3. If you were to teach a friend one of your hobbies, which one would you choose and why?

4. Label your drawing of a musical instrument or a sport using the correct French verb phrase from the word bank.
5. Explain why it is beneficial for people to have more than one hobby. What might happen if someone only ever did one activity?
6. Translate the sentence 'J'aime lire' into English and suggest one other hobby that could be added to this category of 'quiet' activities.
