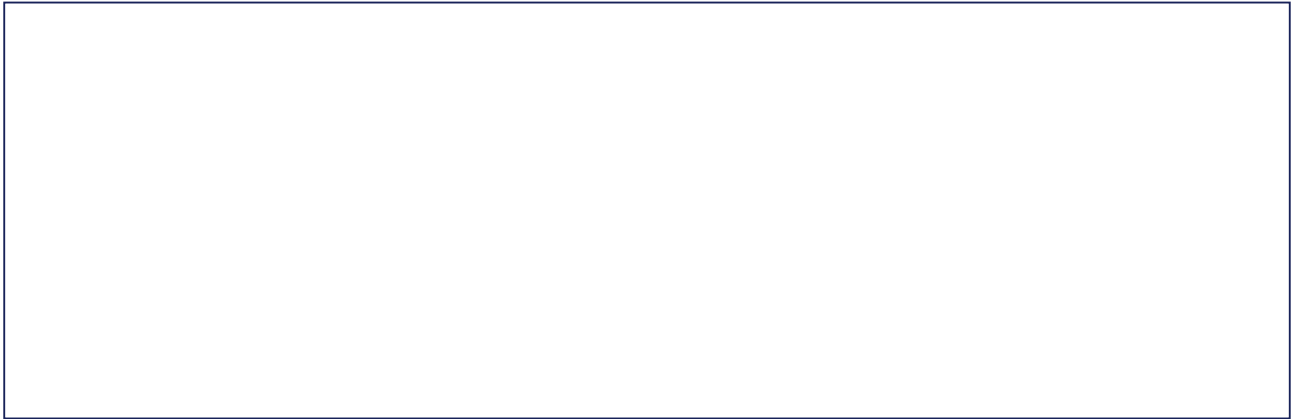
7. 7. How do you say 'break time' in French? A) le sport B) la récréation* C) la classe D) le travail (1 mark)
