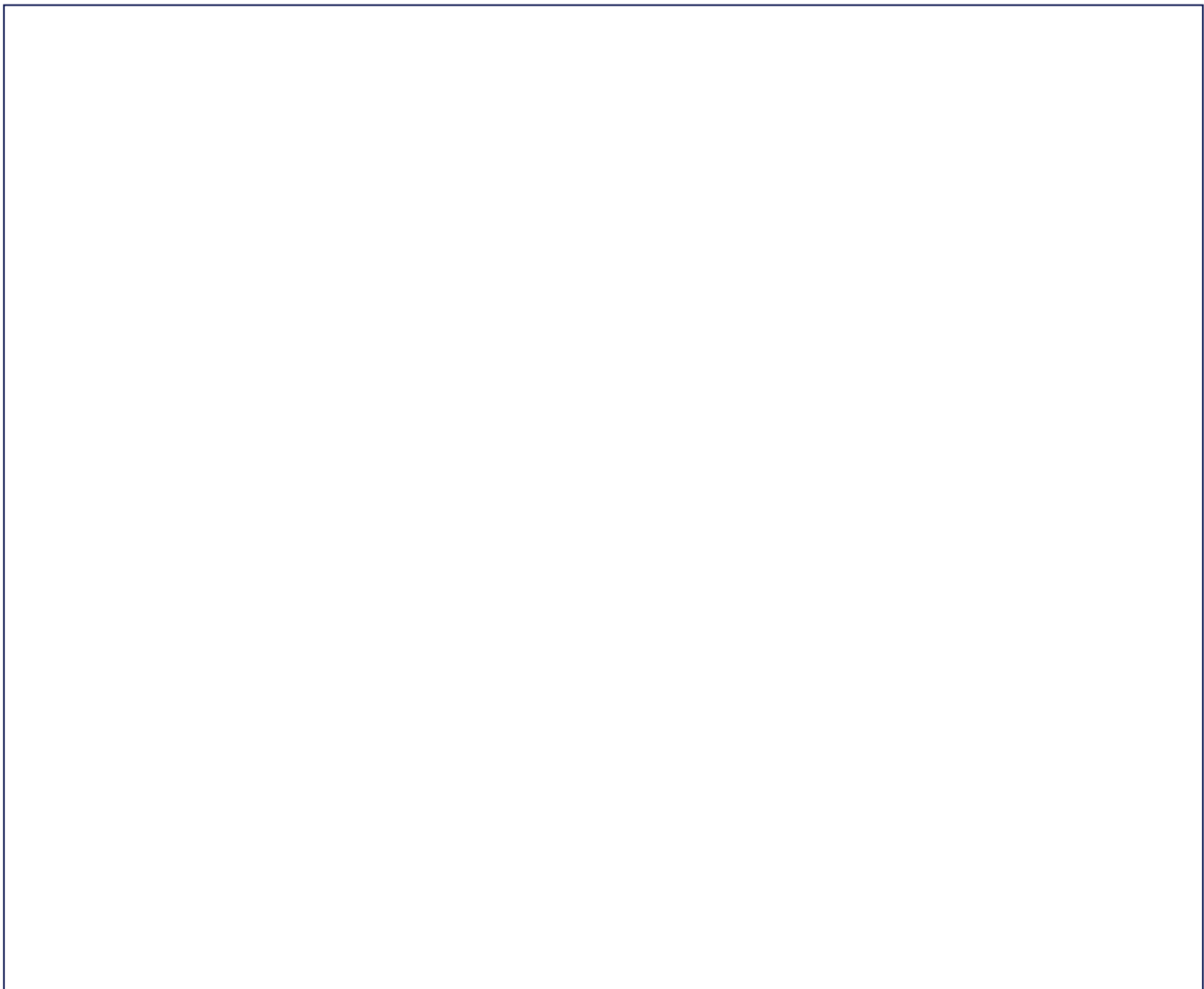


Rosa's Sporting Adventure in France

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary related to sports and physical activities.

Follow the drawing prompt below to create your sporting scene. Use your French word bank to label the activities you have drawn. Ensure your labels are spelt correctly using accurate French accents.

Draw: Draw a vibrant and busy sports center scene. Include at least four different sports being played. Use a bright, colorful cartoon style. Ensure there is space around each activity to add a clear label in French. Include Rosa the parrot perched on a basketball hoop, cheering on the athletes.



Label words: le football · le tennis · la natation · le basket · le rugby · le cyclisme · jouer · faire

Steps:

1. Label three different sports you have drawn using the French terms from the word bank.
2. Explain why we use 'le' for some sports and 'la' for others in French. How does this affect the way we describe our favorite sport?
3. Compare and contrast two sports from your drawing. Which one requires more equipment? Justify your answer.
4. What might happen if you wanted to change the sentence 'Je joue au football' to describe a different sport? Explain the rule.

5. If you were to add a new sport to your drawing that is not in the word bank, how would you research the correct French term? Describe your method.
6. Extension: Write a short sentence in French describing which sport is the most difficult to learn and why.
