6. 6. Which sport requires you to be in a swimming pool? (Answer in French) (1 mark)

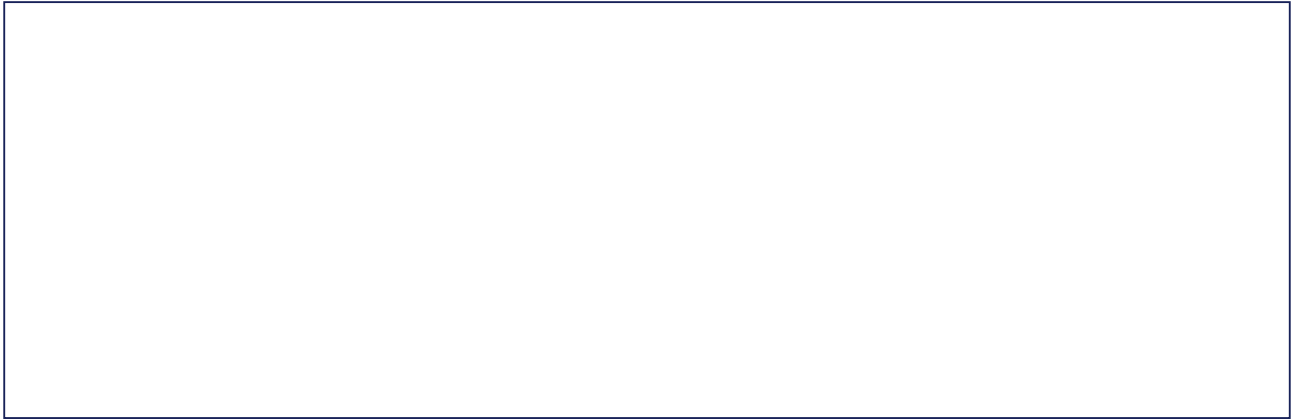
7. 7. How would you say 'I like' in French? A) Je joue B) Je vais C) J'aime* D) Le sport (1 mark)
