

Rosa's Transport Travel Log

Learning objective: To learn and use French vocabulary for different modes of transport and express how to travel to a destination.

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a big trip! Use this travel log to help Rosa practice her French. Choose a destination and a way to travel, then fill in the boxes below to describe your journey in French and English.

Word bank: en train (by train) · en bus (by bus) · en voiture (by car) · en avion (by plane) · en vélo (by bike) · à pied (on foot) · la destination (the destination) · je voyage (I travel)

1. Ma destination: Where are you traveling to? Write the name of your destination and why you want to go there. (2 marks)

2. Le mode de transport: Which French word from the word bank will you use for your travel? Write a full sentence starting with 'Je voyage...'. (2 marks)

3. Le prix du billet: If your train ticket costs £12.50, how would you write that amount in dollars and cents? Imagine you pay with a £20 note; how much change would you receive? (3 marks)

4. Mes bagages: List three things you need to pack for your journey. Write them in English, then try to think of the French word for one of them (e.g., 'un livre' for book). (3 marks)

5. Le voyage: Describe what you might see out of the window during your journey. Use your best French vocabulary for things you might spot, such as trees or clouds. (4 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you create a conversation between two people at a station using at least two French transport words? Remember to be polite!
