

Rosa's French Verb Challenge: Present and Past Tenses

Learning objective: To recognize and use common French verbs in the present tense and the perfect tense (passé composé) for Grade 4 learners.

Read the front of each flashcard to see the verb or phrase. Try to recall the correct translation or tense before checking the answer on the right side. Rosa the parrot has included some helpful hints for you!

What is the French infinitive for 'to eat'?

Manger

Translate 'Je joue' into English.

I play or I am playing

What is the English translation of 'J'ai mangé'?

I ate or I have eaten

Translate 'Il regarde' into English.

He watches or He is watching

How do you say 'I have watched' in French?

J'ai regardé

What is the French infinitive for 'to be'?

Être

Translate 'Nous habitons' into English.

We live

What is the French infinitive for 'to have'?

Avoir

Translate 'Elle a fini' into English.

She finished or She has finished

Translate 'Tu parles' into English.

You speak (singular/informal)

What is the English translation of 'Ils ont dansé'?

They danced or They have danced

Rosa asks: Is 'Je chante' in the present or past tense?
