Learning objective: To identify and use common French verbs in the present tense, focusing on regular -er verbs and basic irregular verbs.

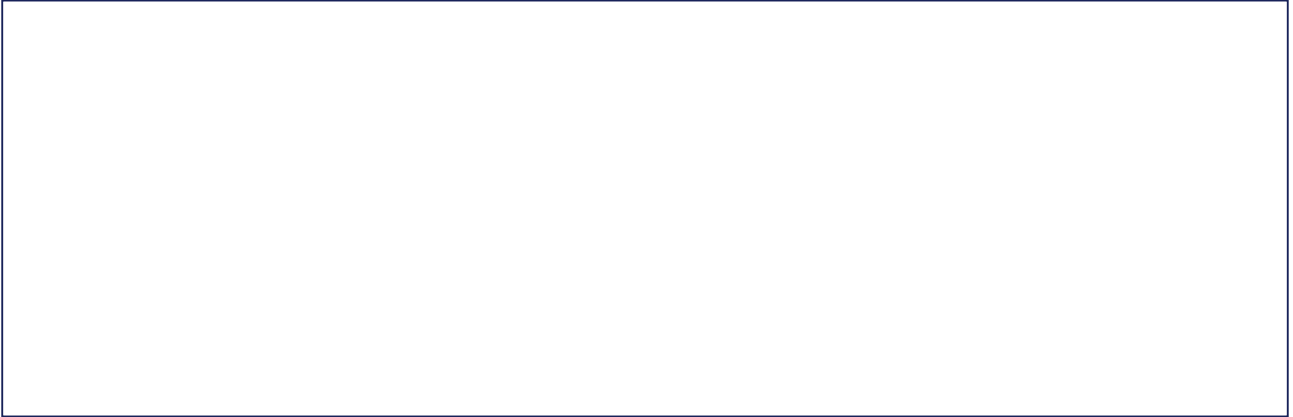
