

Rosa's Weather Diary: Mon Journal de Météo

Learning objective: To be able to describe the weather in French using appropriate vocabulary and sentences.

Rosa the parrot has been flying across France to record the weather in different regions. Use this diary template to practice your own French weather vocabulary. Look at the word bank to help you write full sentences, such as 'Il fait beau' (It is lovely/nice) or 'Il pleut' (It is raining).

Word bank: Il fait beau - It is nice/lovely · Il fait froid - It is cold · Il fait chaud - It is hot · Il pleut - It is raining · Il y a du soleil - It is sunny · Il y a du vent - It is windy · Le ciel est gris - The sky is grey · Aujourd'hui - Today

1. La Météo d'Aujourd'hui: Write the date and describe the weather outside today using a full sentence in French. (2 marks)

2. Le Lieu (The Location): Where are you recording this weather from? Write the name of your town or city and describe what you can see in the sky. (2 marks)

3. Activités: Based on the weather you described, what is one activity you can do? Write this in French (e.g., 'Je joue au football' or 'Je lis un livre'). (2 marks)

4. Prévision (Forecast): If you could choose the weather for tomorrow, what would you choose? Write a sentence starting with 'Demain, je voudrais...' (Tomorrow, I would like...). (2 marks)

5. Comparaison: How is the weather today different from yesterday? Use French vocabulary to compare the two days. (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Research one city in France. Find out what the weather is like there today and write a short weather report in French for that city.
