

Finn's Amazing Biome Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and sort animals into their correct natural habitats (biomes) including the ocean, the desert, and the forest.

Finn the dolphin is traveling the world! He needs your help to make sure all his friends are living in the right places. Look at the word bank of animals below. Draw a line from each animal to the habitat where they belong. If you aren't sure, think about where they might find water, shade, or space to swim!

Word bank: Polar Bear · Camel · Clownfish · Squirrel · Octopus · Fennec Fox

1. Which animal lives in the hot, sandy desert? (Hint: It has a big hump on its back!) (2 marks)

2. Where do the clownfish and the octopus like to swim? (2 marks)

3. The squirrel lives in the forest. Why does it need trees? (2 marks)

4. If you had £1 to buy a ticket to visit one of these homes, which biome would you choose and why? (2 marks)

5. Can you name one thing that a polar bear needs to stay healthy in its cold home? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favorite animal in its home. Make sure to draw what the weather looks like there—is it sunny, snowy, or underwater?



Extension challenge: Talk to a friend about what you would pack in your suitcase if you were going to visit the desert. Would you need a thick coat or a sun hat? Why?
