

Finn's Climate Explorer Fact-File

Learning objective: To identify and describe different weather patterns and climates around the world, using descriptive language.

Join Finn the dolphin on a world tour! Look at the different places Finn has visited. Use the fact-file boxes below to describe what the weather is like in each place and what clothes you might need to wear there. You can use the word bank to help you with your ideas.

Word bank: sunny · cold · rainy · snowy · hot · windy · coat · hat · shorts · boots · umbrella

1. The Sunny Place: What is the weather like here and what would you wear to stay cool? (2 marks)

2. The Snowy Place: Is it hot or cold? What clothes do you need to keep warm? (2 marks)

3. The Rainy Place: What do you see falling from the sky? What do you use to stay dry? (2 marks)

4. My Favorite Weather: Which type of weather do you like best and why? (2 marks)

5. Finn's Journey: If you could travel to a place with any weather, where would you go? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Draw a picture of yourself dressed for a very windy day in the box provided on your worksheet.
