

Finn's Big Blue Map Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and name the world's continents and oceans, and represent them visually.

Follow Finn the Dolphin as he swims around the world! Use your pencils and crayons to complete the map. Refer to the word bank to add labels to your drawing.

Draw: Draw a large map of the world on the page. Use a blue crayon to color in the oceans and a green or brown crayon to draw the shapes of the continents. Add Finn the Dolphin swimming in the Atlantic Ocean. Make sure your lines are clear and simple so that you can label the different parts of the world using the words provided.



Label words: Ocean · Land · Continents · Sea · World

Steps:

1. Finn is swimming in the big blue water. What do we call these large areas of water? Write your answer here.
2. Draw a small boat on one of the oceans and a tree on one of the continents.
3. How many continents can you count on your map? Write the number.
4. Which color would you use to show the water on a map? Why?
5. Look at your drawing. Can you name one continent you have drawn?
