

Finn's World Explorer Fact-File

Learning objective: To identify and name the world's continents and oceans, and understand the difference between land and water.

Help Finn the Dolphin map the world! Look at a globe or an atlas and fill in this fact-file. Use the word bank to help you spell the names of the places you find. For each section, draw a picture or write a sentence to show what you have learned about our planet.

Word bank: Europe · Africa · Asia · America · Antarctica · Australia · Pacific Ocean · Atlantic Ocean · land · water

1. My Favorite Continent: Choose one continent to explore. What is its name and what is it like there? (2 marks)

2. The Big Blue: Can you name one of the oceans Finn swims in? How do you know it is an ocean? (2 marks)

3. Land vs Water: How many continents can you count on a globe? Are there more patches of land or more patches of water? (2 marks)

4. Ocean Life: If you were a dolphin like Finn, which ocean would you choose to visit and why? (2 marks)

5. Global Discovery: Which continent is home to the United Kingdom? Can you find it on a map? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Pick two continents and draw a line connecting them. If you were traveling between them, would you travel across land or swim through an ocean?
