

Finn's Earth Adventure

Learning objective: To understand that the Earth is made of layers and that sometimes the ground moves, which we call an earthquake.

Color in the picture of Finn the dolphin and the Earth's layers. Read the facts about our planet with your teacher or grown-up.

Colour this: A large, friendly cross-section diagram of the Earth showing three distinct layers: the outer crust, the thick middle mantle, and the round core in the center. On the left side of the drawing, Finn the dolphin is smiling and swimming in a blue ocean that sits on top of the Earth's crust. The lines should be bold and clear for young children to color. Include simple shapes like wavy lines for the water and a circular shape for the Earth.



Steps:

1. Label the 'Crust' on the top layer of the Earth in your picture.
2. Label 'Finn' next to the dolphin in the ocean.
