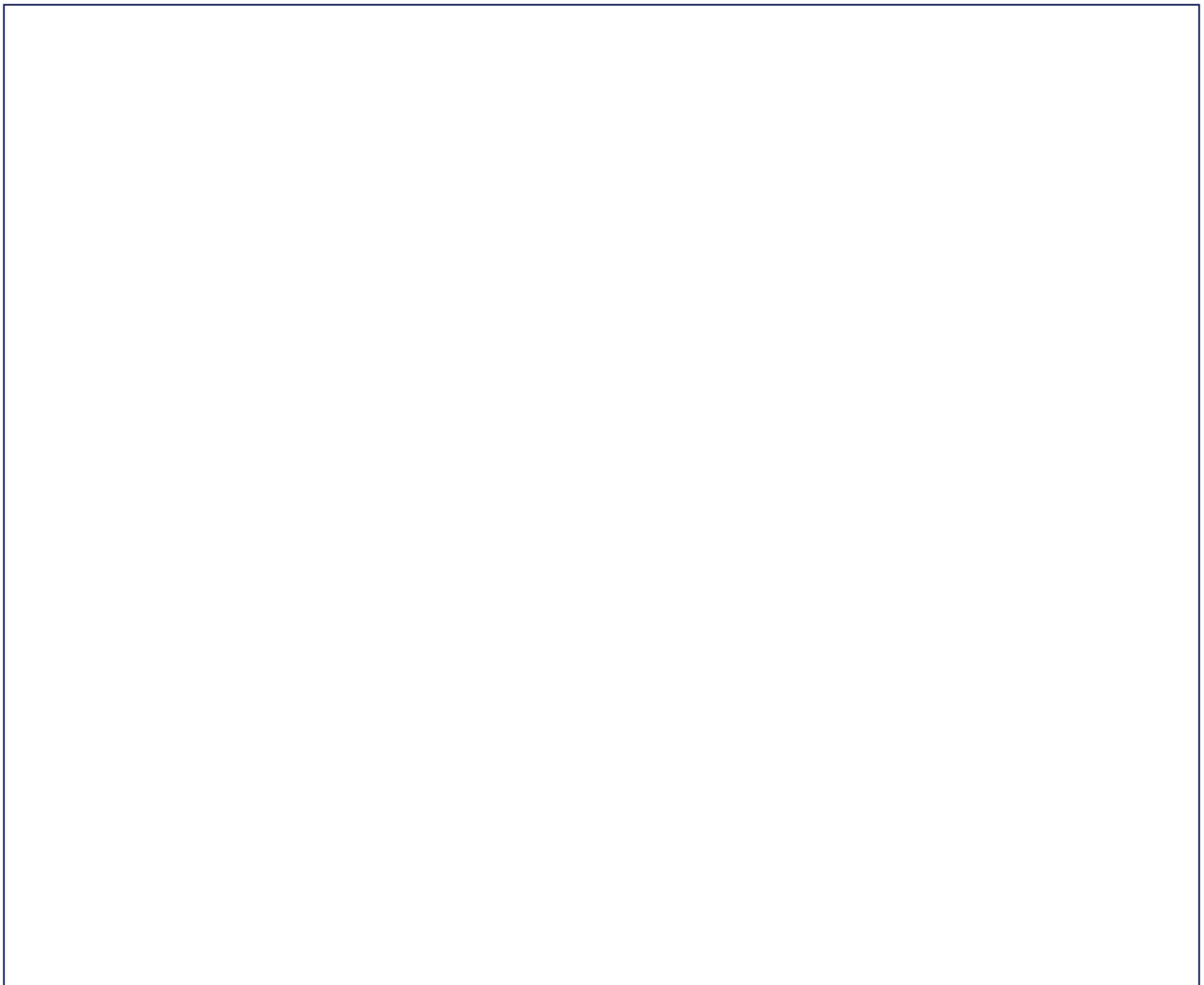


# Finn's Geography Adventure

*Learning objective: To identify and distinguish between physical features (natural) and human features (man-made) in our environment.*

Look at the list of words below. Choose some to add to your picture to show the difference between things that are natural and things that people have built.

**Draw: Draw a large landscape scene. Include a winding river and a tall mountain to represent physical geography. Add a small village with a road, a house, and a bridge crossing the river to represent human geography. Use bright colors and clear outlines.**



*Label words: river · house · mountain · road · tree · bridge · store · beach*

3. Which of your drawings is a human feature made by people? Write the name here.
