

# Finn's Community Explorer Fact-File

*Learning objective: To understand that people live in different places and to describe who lives in their own local community.*

Finn the Dolphin travels all over the world and loves learning about the people who live in different places. Use this fact-file to explore your own community. Talk to a grown-up about who lives near you and draw a picture to match your answers.

## 1. My Neighborhood: Who are the people that live in your street or local community? (2 marks)

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## 2. Types of Homes: What kind of homes do people in your community live in? (e.g. houses or flats) (2 marks)

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## 3. Special Places: What is a place in your community where people go to meet or play? (2 marks)

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## 4. Helping Hands: Who are the people who help us in our community, like a teacher or a shopkeeper? (2 marks)

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## 5. Finn's Question: Why is it good to have many different people living in our community? (2 marks)

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*Extension challenge: Go on a 'community walk' with an adult. Count how many different types of houses you see and draw a tally chart to show what you found.*
