

Finn's Rainforest Explorer Fact-File

Learning objective: To identify and describe key features of a rainforest environment, including the plants and animals that live there.

Join Finn the dolphin on a land adventure! Use the word bank to help you fill in your very own rainforest fact-file. Think about what the weather is like, what the trees look like, and which animals you might spot hiding in the leaves.

Word bank: hot · wet · tall trees · bright birds · green leaves · rain · monkeys · insects

1. The Weather: What is it like in the rainforest? Is it hot or cold? Is it dry or wet? (2 marks)

2. The Plants: Describe the trees and leaves you might see in the rainforest. (2 marks)

3. The Animals: Which animals live in the rainforest? Can you name two? (2 marks)

4. My Discovery: If you visited the rainforest today, what is the most exciting thing you would want to see? (2 marks)

5. Staying Safe: Why is it important to look after the rainforest homes for all the animals? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are a rainforest explorer! Draw a map of your own rainforest, including a big river for Finn to splash in and a path for you to walk along.
