

Finn's Market Map: My Trading Adventure

Learning objective: To understand that trade involves exchanging goods for money and that items come from different places.

Help Finn the dolphin explore how shops get their items. Talk to a grown-up about where your favorite fruit or toy might have come from. Use the boxes below to plan your own little store. Draw what you are selling, how much it costs in pounds (£), and where you found it.

Word bank: trade · money · store · coins · travel · exchange · price · pounds

1. My Store Item: What are you selling in your store today? Draw it and write its name.

2. The Price: How much does your item cost? Write the amount in pounds (£).

3. Where did it come from? Did your item travel on a boat, a plane, or a truck to get to the store?

4. Trading Talk: If a friend wants to buy your item, what money will they give you?

5. Finn's Map: Draw a line from your store to where you think your item was made.

Extension challenge: Ask a grown-up to show you a label on a piece of clothing or food. Find the name of the country it came from and try to find that country on a globe or map with Finn!
