

Finn's Weather Adventure

Learning objective: To observe and describe the weather and identify how it changes throughout the seasons.

Finn the dolphin is exploring the coast! Look at the different weather scenes below and draw what you might see outside your own window today. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Draw a large landscape scene. Include a big sky at the top for weather elements. In the bottom corner, draw a small version of Finn the dolphin wearing a sun hat. Use bright colors for sunny weather, or grey and blue for rainy weather. Add trees or flowers to show how the environment looks in your chosen weather.



Label words: sunny · rainy · cloudy · windy · snowy

Steps:

1. Draw a picture of what the weather looks like outside today in the box below.
2. What clothes do you need to wear when it is raining? Draw them next to your weather picture.
3. If it is very hot and sunny, would you wear a thick winter coat or a t-shirt?
4. Which weather word from the bank best describes today?
5. Can you draw a tiny picture of an umbrella next to your rain clouds?
