1. Geographical Features: Describe the rivers and landscape of Ancient China. Why were these important for early settlers? (3 marks)

2. The Emperor and Dynasties: Explain what a dynasty is and name one famous Chinese Emperor or dynasty you have discovered. (3 marks)

3. Amazing Inventions: Choose two inventions from Ancient China (e.g., paper, gunpowder, the compass). How did these change the world? (4 marks)

4. Trade and Travel: What was the Silk Road, and what kinds of goods were traded along these routes? (3 marks)

5. Daily Life: What was life like for a farmer or a craftsperson in Ancient China? How does this compare to life today? (4 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are a merchant traveling on the Silk Road. Write a short journal entry (3-4 sentences) describing one item you are carrying to trade and the scenery you see along the way.
