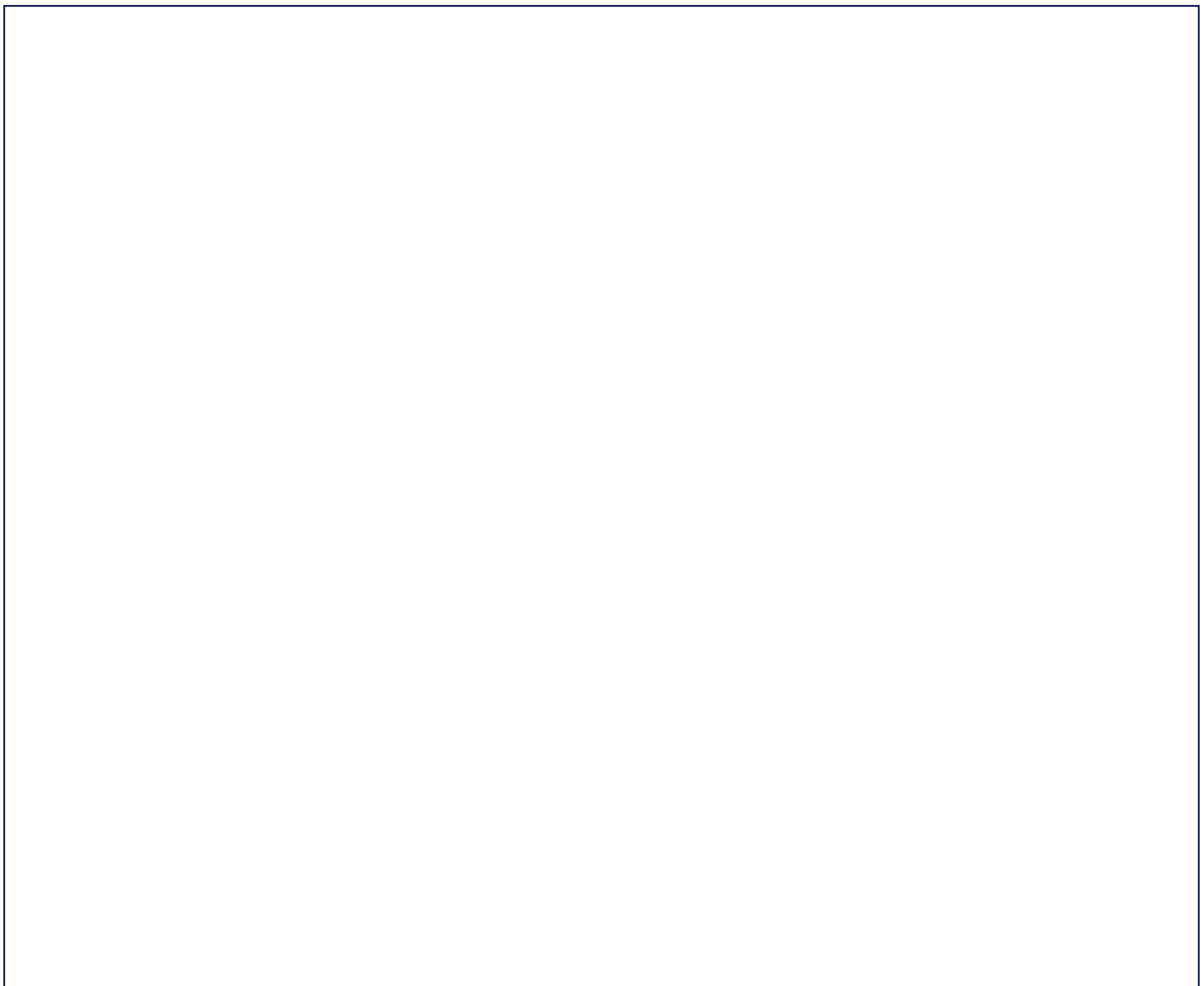


Ellie's History Heroes: Celebrating Amazing People

Learning objective: To learn about significant individuals from Black history and express understanding through drawing and labelling.

Today, we are learning about people who have made our world a better place. Ellie the Elephant has been reading stories about heroes from history. Pick a famous person you have learned about this month, draw them in the frame, and use the word bank to label your picture.

Draw: Draw a portrait of a person from Black history inside the large box. Use bright colors. Include a background that shows something they did, like a book if they were a writer, a microphone if they were a speaker, or a peaceful park if they stood up for fairness. Ensure the style is clear and simple for 3-5 year olds.



Label words: Hero · Kind · Brave · History · Change

Steps:

1. Who is the hero you chose to draw today?
2. Why is this person special to you? (e.g., they were brave, they were kind)
3. Draw a small star next to your hero to show they are a star of history.
4. Use the word bank to label one thing you have drawn.
5. If you could tell this hero 'thank you', what would you say?
