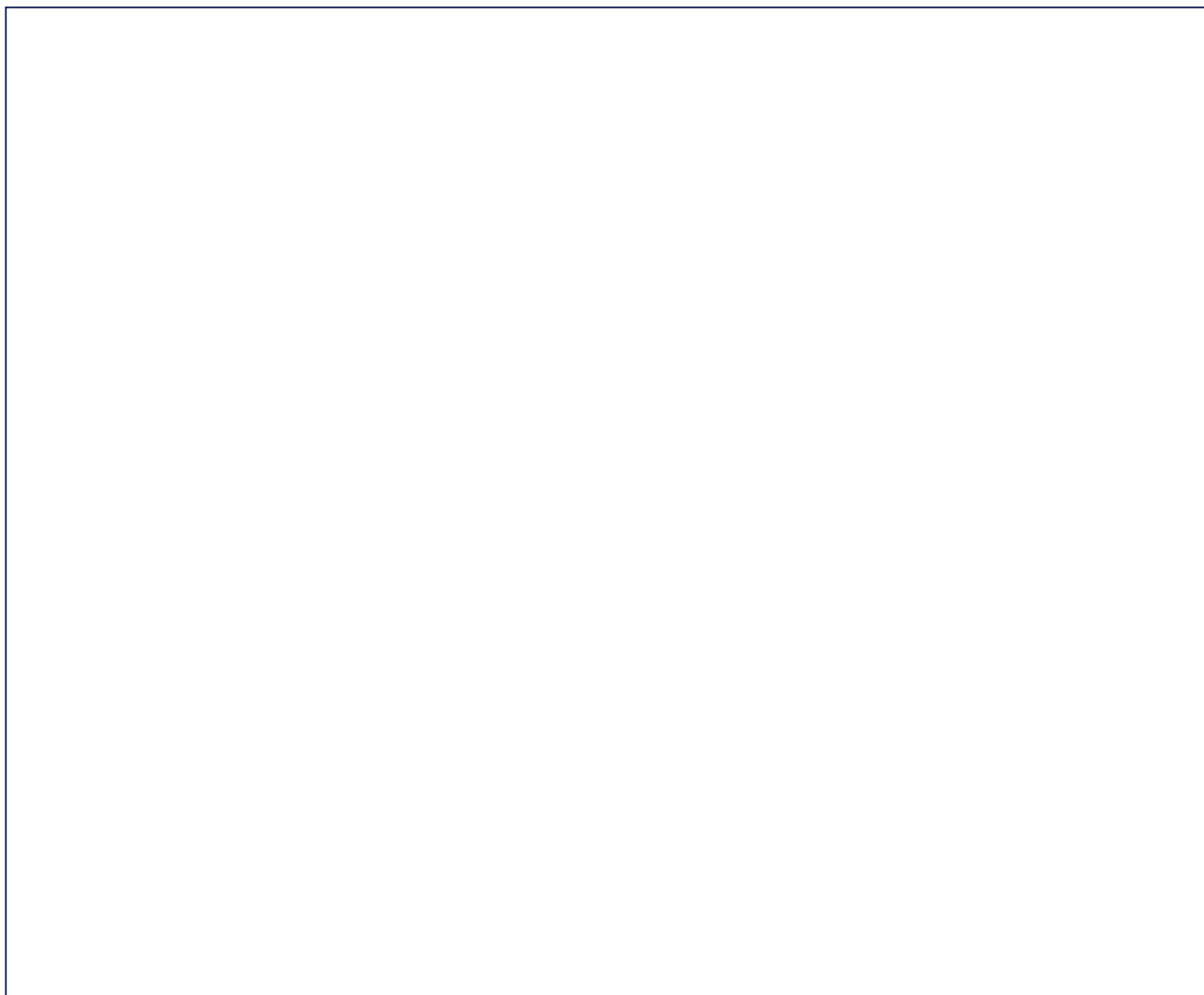


Nova's Moon Mission: Drawing Neil Armstrong

Learning objective: To learn about the first person to walk on the Moon and represent historical information through drawing.

Today, we are looking at history! Nova the owl wants to know about the first person to walk on the Moon. Use your pencils to draw Neil Armstrong standing on the Moon. Use the word bank to add labels to your picture.

Draw: Draw a large, dusty grey cratered surface at the bottom of the page for the Moon. In the center, draw an astronaut wearing a round white helmet and a bulky space suit. In the background, draw a dark sky filled with yellow or white sparkling stars. Include a flag planted in the ground next to the astronaut.



Label words: Moon · Astronaut · Flag · Boots · Stars

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a big circle for the Moon and a person wearing a big, white astronaut suit standing on it.
2. Step 2: Draw a bright flag next to the astronaut. What color is the flag?
3. Step 3: Draw lots of twinkling stars in the dark space sky above the Moon.
4. Step 4: Can you label the astronaut's big boots that helped him walk on the moon?
5. Step 5: Write your name at the bottom of your historical space picture!
