

My Moon Explorer Fact-File: Neil Armstrong

Learning objective: To learn about significant individuals from the past and recognize that some people have shaped history.

Help Ellie the elephant learn about history! Use the word bank to fill in the boxes below. You can draw what you think Neil Armstrong saw when he looked out of his rocket window.

1. Who is our space explorer? Write the name of the man who first walked on the Moon. (2 marks)

2. What did he travel in? Describe the vehicle he used to fly into the sky. (2 marks)

3. What did he wear? Tell us what he needed to put on to stay safe in space. (2 marks)

4. Where did he land? Name the big, bright object in the night sky where he walked. (2 marks)

5. What did he leave behind? Tell us what he made in the dust when he took a step. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are an astronaut like Neil Armstrong. Draw a picture of what you would take with you on your trip to the Moon and label your items.
