How many millimetres are in 1 centimetre?

10 millimetres

Max the monkey wants to calculate the distance around a rectangular garden. What is he calculating: perimeter or area?

Perimeter

How many metres are in 1 kilometre?

1,000 metres

If a square has a side length of 4cm, what is its area?

16cm² (4cm x 4cm)

How many grams are in 1 kilogram?

1,000 grams

What is the formula for calculating the area of a rectangle?

Length x Width

How many millilitres are in 1 liter?

1,000 millilitres

If a rectangle has a length of 5cm and a width of 3cm, what is its perimeter?

16cm (5 + 3 + 5 + 3)

Convert 2.5 metres into centimetres.

250 centimetres

If a bag of apples costs £2.50 per kilogram, how much would 2 kilograms cost?

£5.00

True or False: 500ml is equivalent to 0.5 litres.

True

Which unit would you use to measure the distance between two UK cities: metres or kilometres?

Kilometres
