

Max's Musical Dynamics: The Volume of Sound

Turn the Volume Up! Master the Art of Dynamics with Max the Monkey.

- **Forte** means 'strong' or 'loud'. When you see this symbol, the music should be played with plenty of energy.
- **Piano** means 'soft' or 'quiet'. Use this dynamic when you want the music to sound gentle or delicate.
- A **Crescendo** is a gradual increase in volume. Imagine a sound growing from a whisper to a roar.
- A **Diminuendo** is a gradual decrease in volume. Think of a bouncing ball that slowly loses its energy until it stops.
- **Mezzo** is a prefix meaning 'medium'. If you see 'Mezzo-forte', it means moderately loud.

Did you know? Did you know? Dynamics are written in Italian! Because music is an international language, composers from all over the world use these traditional terms so that musicians playing a piece for the first time know exactly how loud or quiet to play.
