

# Celebrating Our Unique Community

*Learning objective: To understand and celebrate the diversity of individuals and groups within our society, recognising that everyone has unique qualities.*

Max the monkey is organising a 'Community Fair' and needs your help to match the unique qualities and experiences of our BookFlik friends to the correct activity stalls. Read the descriptions of the characters provided in the word bank and sort them into the correct 'Community Contribution' category below. Explain why each person's unique background makes our community stronger.

*Word bank: Pip the bookworm who loves sharing stories from different cultures. · Nova the owl who shares fascinating facts about the night sky from around the world. · Finn the dolphin who has travelled the globe and mapped different sea life habitats. · Rosa the parrot who speaks two languages and teaches others how to say 'hello' in different tongues. · Zara the zebra who uses traditional patterns from many countries in her art projects.*

**1. Which character would best help run a stall about 'Global Communication'? Explain how their bilingual skills help create an inclusive environment. (2 marks)**

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**2. If you were hosting a 'Storytelling Corner', why is it helpful to have someone like Pip who collects stories from everywhere? (2 marks)**

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**3. How does Finn's knowledge of geography and different oceans help us appreciate the wider world? (2 marks)**

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**4. Why is it important to include people with different skills and perspectives, like Nova and Zara, when planning a school event? (2 marks)**

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**5. Imagine a new friend joins your class who speaks a different language or has different traditions. Write one welcoming sentence you could say to make them feel included. (2 marks)**

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**Draw:** Draw a 'Unity Mural' featuring Pip, Nova, Finn, Rosa, and Zara working together. Include symbols or patterns that represent the different cultures and talents they each bring to the group.



*Extension challenge: Research a traditional festival celebrated in another part of the world. Create a small 'Entry Ticket' costing £1.50 for your stall at the Community Fair, and write a brief description of why people should visit to learn something new about that culture.*
