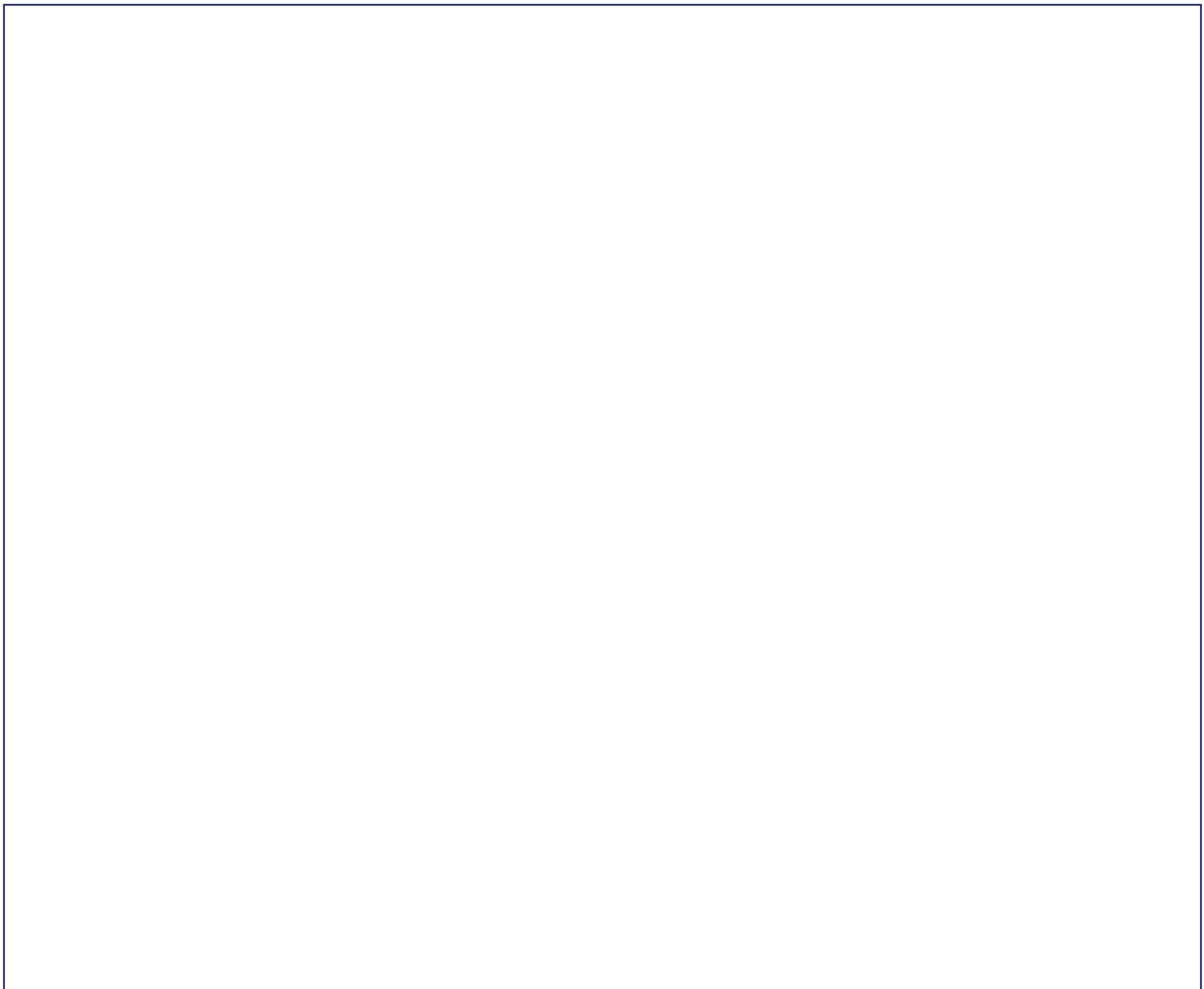


My Kind Friends

Learning objective: To understand what makes a good friend and how we can show kindness to others in our community.

Think about a friend you like to play with. Use the space below to draw a picture of you and your friend doing something kind together. You can use the word bank to help you label your drawing.

Draw: Create a large scene showing two friends playing together in a garden or a classroom. Use bright colors and clear outlines. Include space for labels and a speech bubble coming from the child character to describe their favorite friendship activity.



Label words: kind · sharing · happy · playing · caring · friend

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw yourself and your friend in the middle of the page.
2. Step 2: Draw an item you are sharing with your friend (like a toy or a book).
3. Step 3: Label your friend using a word from the word bank.
4. Step 4: Draw a big smile on your face to show how it feels to have a friend.
5. Step 5: Write one thing you like to do with your friend in the speech bubble.
