

Being a Kind Friend with Leo the Lion

Learning objective: To understand what makes a good friend, how to share, and how to show kindness to others.

Read the questions with your teacher or grown-up. Think about how Leo the Lion would treat his friends in the forest, then write or draw your answers below.

Leo the Lion is very brave, but he is also very gentle. He loves to play in the forest with all his friends. Leo knows that being a good friend means thinking about how others feel and making sure everyone feels happy when they play together.

1. Leo has a yummy apple. How can he be a kind friend with his apple? (2 marks)

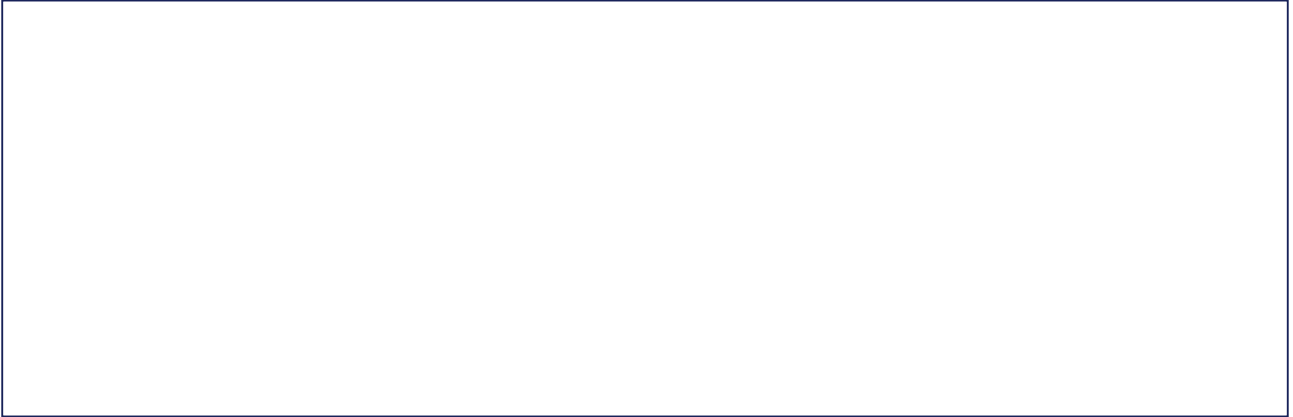
2. If your friend is feeling sad, what is one thing you can do to help them feel better? (2 marks)

3. Why is it important to take turns when playing with a toy or a game? (2 marks)

4. When you are playing in the sandpit, how do you show that you are a good friend? (2 marks)

5. Circle the words from the word bank that describe how a good friend acts. (2 marks)
