**6. 6. What is the word for saying something nice to someone to make them feel good about themselves? (1 word answer) (1 mark)**

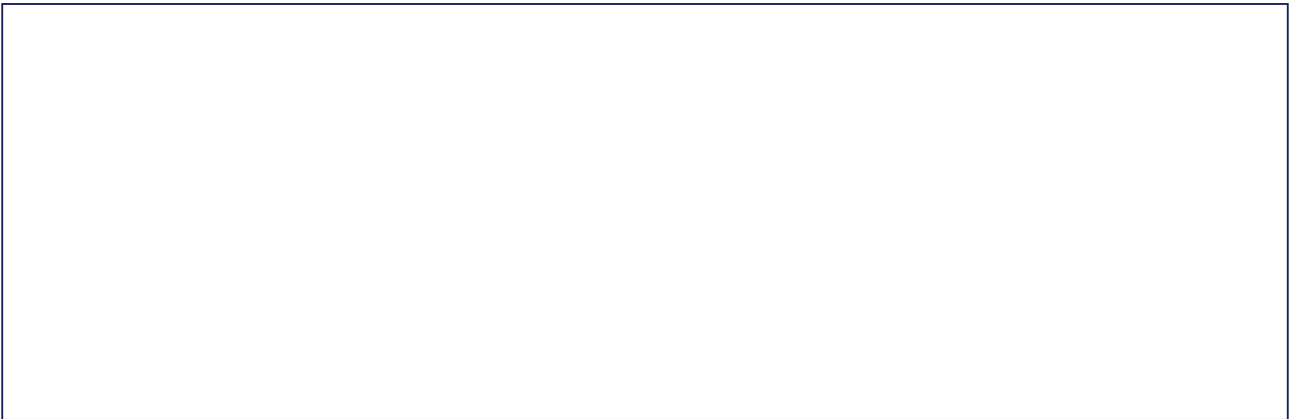
