

My Bonfire Night Fact-File with Nova

Learning objective: To recall key facts about Bonfire Night and express personal observations, supporting Understanding the World (People, Culture and Communities).

Help Nova the owl learn about Bonfire Night! Read the questions carefully and fill in the boxes with your own thoughts and drawings. Talk to a grown-up about why we celebrate this night and how we stay safe around sparklers and fires.

1. What does a bonfire look like? Describe the colors and the feeling of the heat.

2. What sounds do you hear when the fireworks go off in the night sky?

3. How do we stay safe when we are near a bonfire or holding a sparkler?

4. If you were buying a treat at a bonfire party, what would you choose and how much might it cost in £?

5. Why do you think people celebrate Bonfire Night together?

Extension challenge: Ask a grown-up to help you find a pattern in a firework display. Can you draw the pattern you saw on a separate piece of paper, just like Zara the zebra would?
