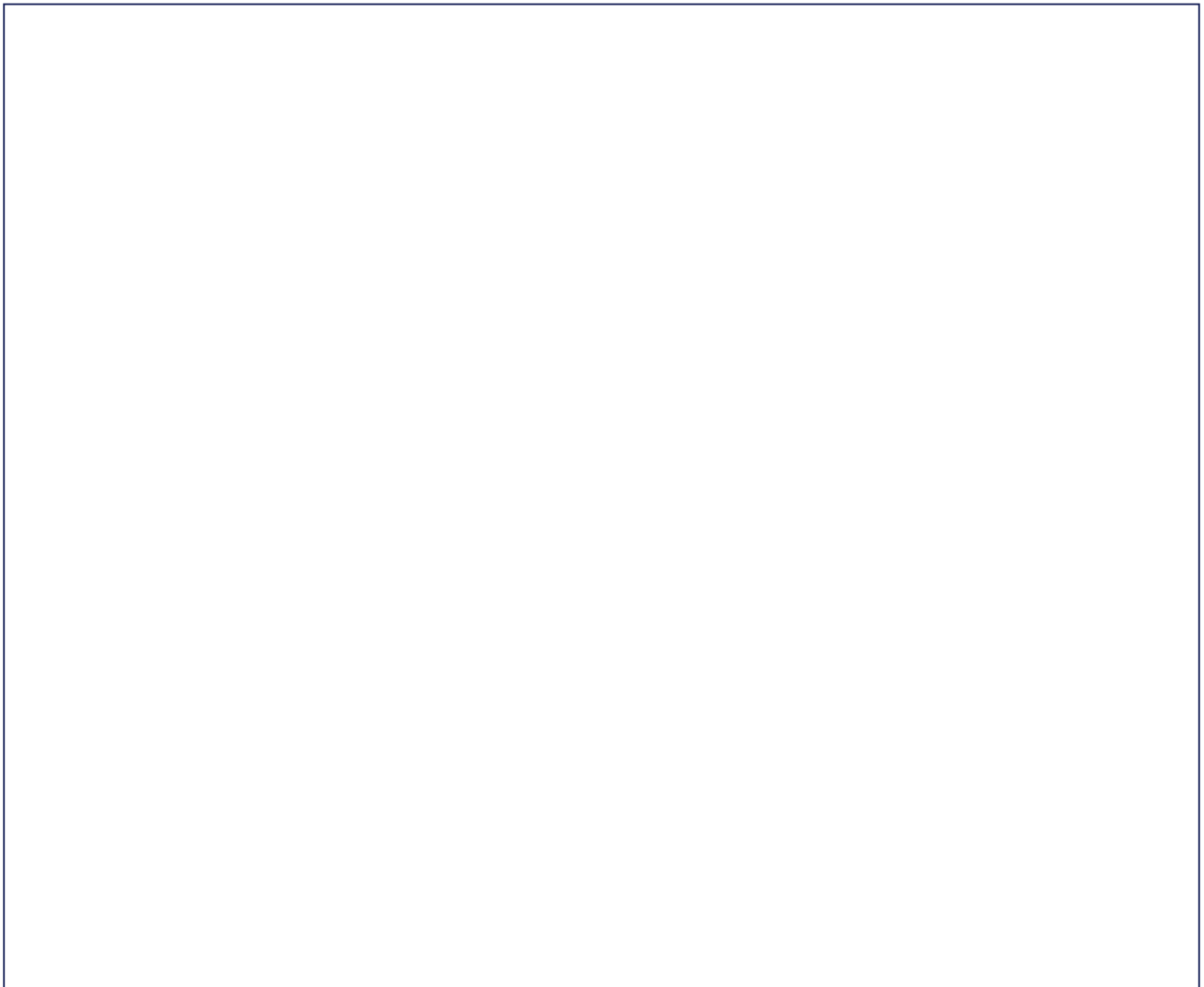


# Easter Time with Pip and Friends

*Learning objective: To explore the symbols of Easter and express understanding through artistic representation.*

Follow the steps below to draw your own Easter scene. Use the word bank to help you label your picture.

**Draw:** Create a bright, spring-themed scene on a landscape piece of paper. In the center, draw a woven basket. Fill the basket with oval-shaped eggs decorated with patterns like stripes or spots. Beside the basket, draw a small, round, fluffy chick. In the background, draw a bright sun and one or two spring flowers with green stems. Use bold, cheerful colors to make the scene feel like a sunny spring morning.



*Label words: egg · basket · flower · chick · sun*

## Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large basket in the middle of your page for Pip the caterpillar to carry his treats.
2. Step 2: Draw three colorful eggs inside the basket. What colors will you choose?
3. Step 3: Draw a fluffy yellow chick standing next to the basket.
4. Step 4: Draw a spring flower, like a daffodil, growing near the basket.
5. Step 5: Label your drawing using at least three words from the word bank.
