

Eid Celebration with Zara the Zebra

Learning objective: To understand how Eid-ul-Fitr is celebrated as a special time of joy, community, and sharing for Muslim families.

5. Eid is a time to visit and spend time with your cousins, grandparents, and parents. Who are these people? (1 mark)
