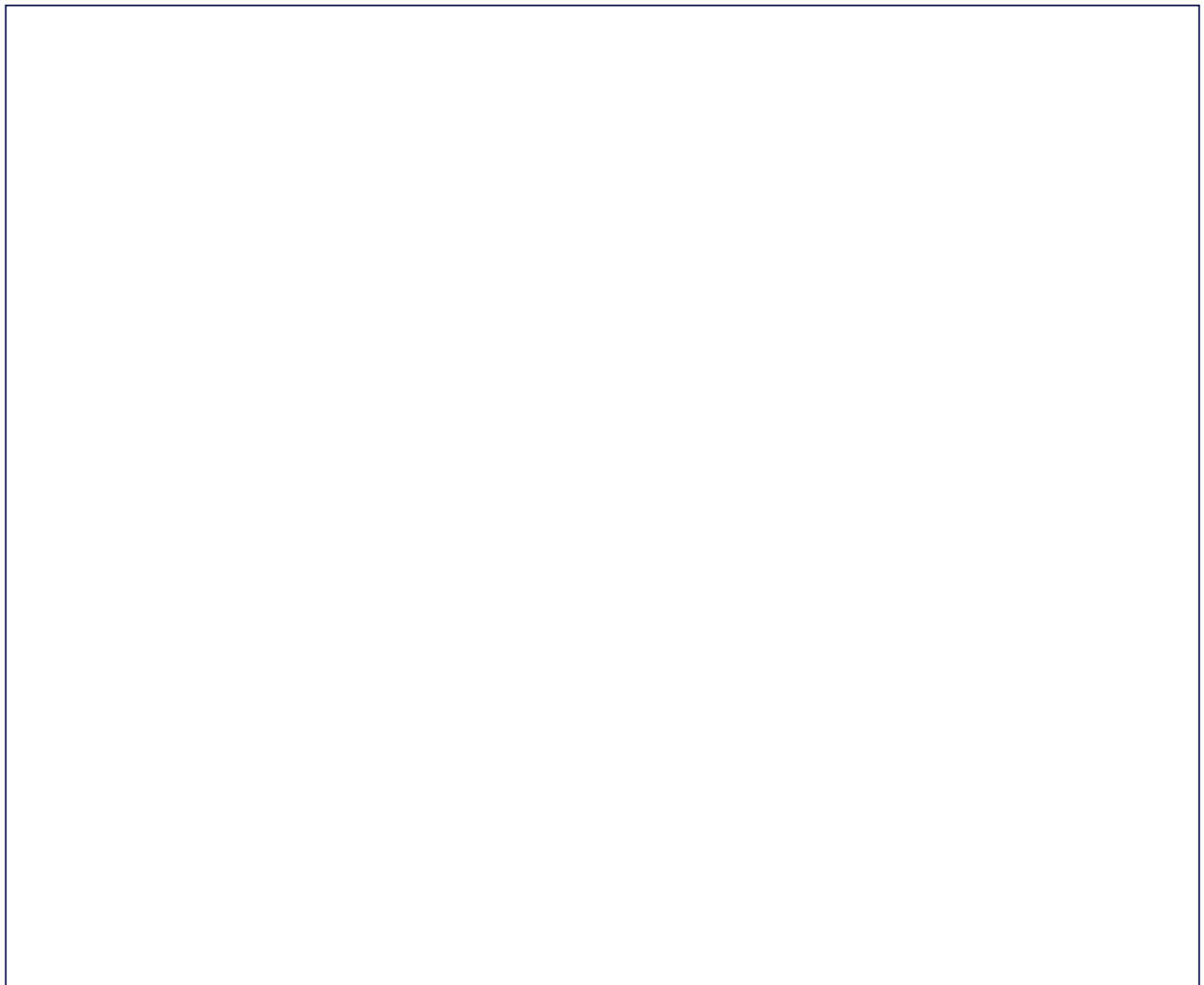


My Special Place of Worship

Learning objective: To identify that people have special places where they gather to pray and celebrate, and to represent these places through drawing.

Today, we are learning about special places where people go to talk to God, pray, or be together in peace. Look at the word bank and think about what makes a building look special. Use your pencils and crayons to create your own peaceful place.

Draw: Draw a large, friendly building that represents a place of worship. Use bright colors for the walls and roof. Include a large door to show everyone is welcome. Add a beautiful window, perhaps with patterns like Zara the zebra would draw, and a bright yellow sun or glowing light to show the place is full of peace and warmth.



Label words: Door · Window · Roof · Light · Peace

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a big, welcoming door for your special place. Why is a door important?
2. Step 2: Draw a window. Is it a square window or a tall, curvy one?
3. Step 3: Draw a light inside or outside the building to show it is a bright, happy place.
4. Step 4: Label your drawing using the words from the word bank.
5. Step 5: Draw a person standing near your building. How do they feel when they visit this place?
