- Fall is the season when the weather gets cooler and the days get shorter.
- Many trees, called deciduous trees, lose their green leaves which turn shades of yellow, orange, and brown.
- The wind blows the dry leaves off the branches, making a lovely crunchy sound when we walk on them.
- Fall is the time for harvest, when farmers collect crops like pumpkins, apples, and corn from the fields.
- Some birds fly away to warmer countries to find food, which is a journey called migration.
- Animals like squirrels are very busy in fall, collecting nuts and seeds to store for the winter.

Did you know? Did you know? Some hedgehogs find a cosy pile of dry leaves to sleep in during the cold winter months. This is called hibernation!
