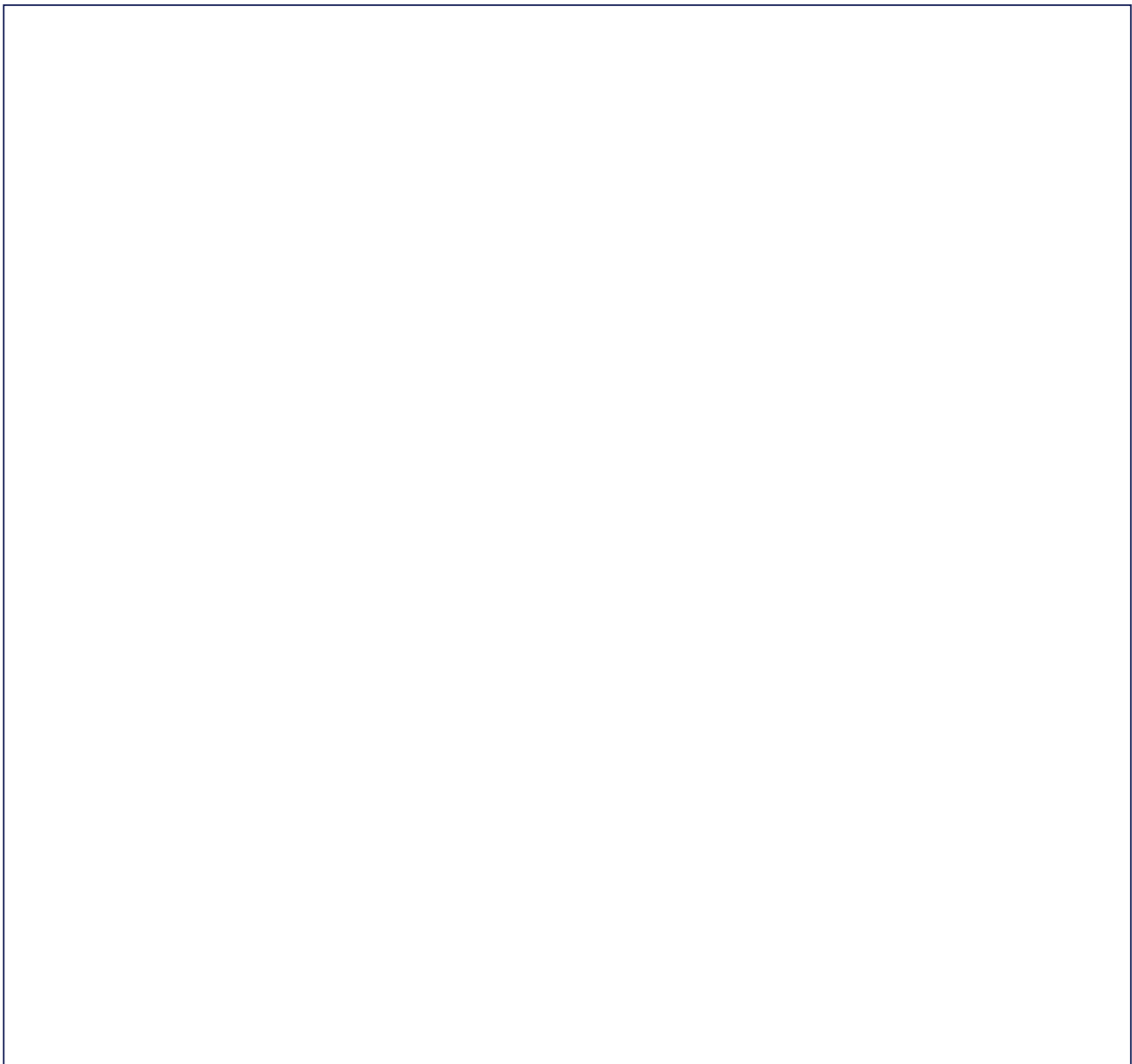


Nova's Material Hunt

Learning objective: To identify and name everyday materials including wood, metal, plastic, and glass.

Look at the objects Nova has found in the garden. Color the items and think about what they are made of. Can you draw a line to label the different materials?
