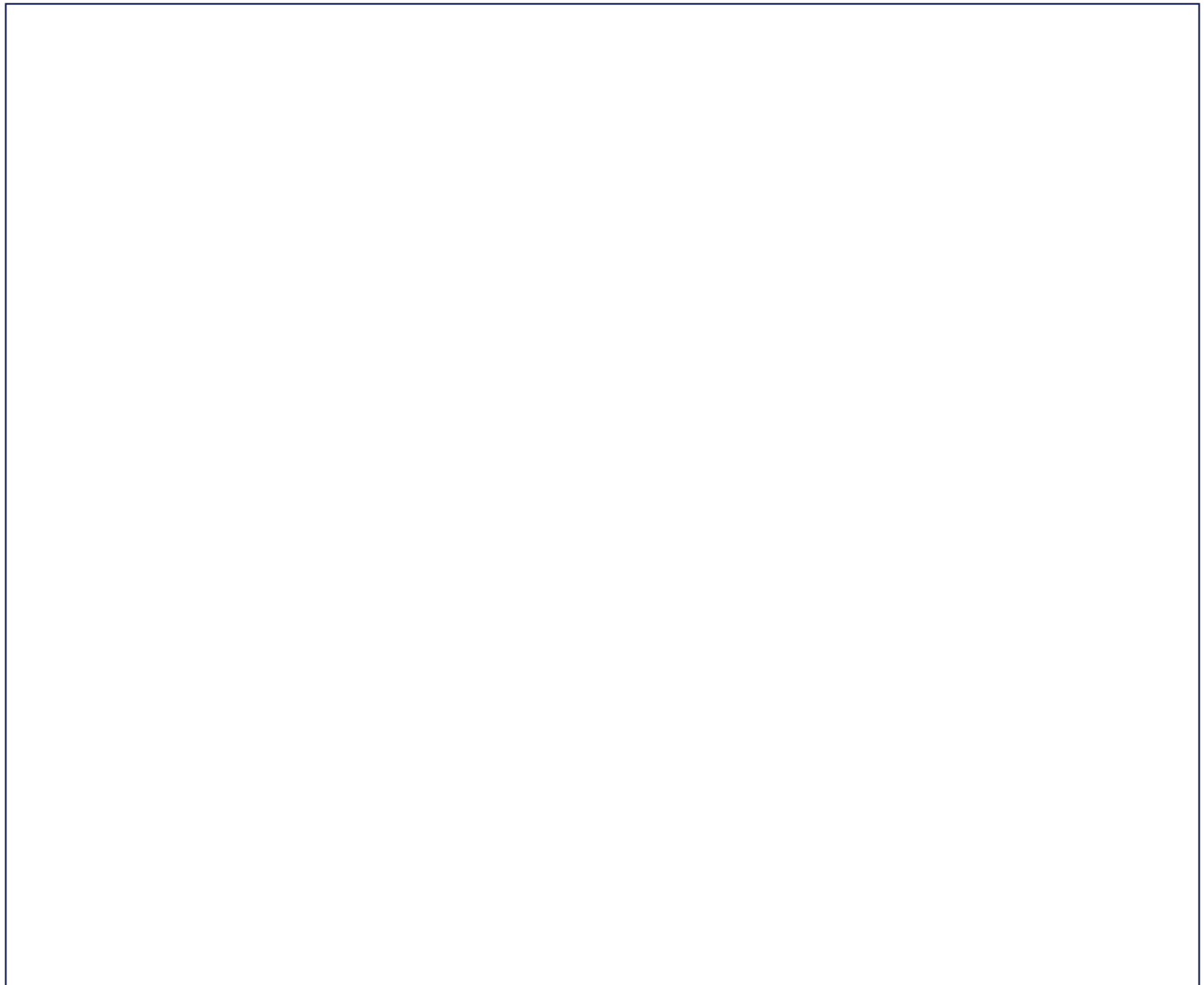


Nova's Seasonal Garden Adventure

Learning objective: To observe and describe the changes that happen across the four seasons.

Follow the steps below to draw how a garden changes throughout the year. Use the word bank to label your pictures.

Draw: Draw four square boxes on your page. In each box, draw a large tree. In the first box, add tiny buds and grass. In the second, add big colorful flowers and a bright yellow sun. In the third, draw red and orange leaves on the branches and on the ground. In the fourth, draw bare branches and white snowflakes falling. Use bright colors for the flowers and soft colors for the winter scene.



Label words: Spring · Summer · Fall · Winter · Sun · Snow · Leaves · Flowers

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a tree with small green buds for Spring. Label the season.
2. Step 2: Draw the same tree with bright flowers and a big sun for Summer. Label it.
3. Step 3: Draw orange and brown leaves falling from the tree for Fall. Label it.
4. Step 4: Draw the tree with no leaves and white snow on the ground for Winter. Label it.
5. Which season do you like the best? Tell an adult why.
